Always the 3rd Sunday of each month!

Keep this list handy so you will have an idea of what is needed! Your donations are deeply appreciated by those who receive them! To some of these men and women, this is the only contact they have from home.

Some suggested items: Candy...individually packaged items are great, as we can put them in more than one mailing (No chocolate!); individually packaged snack foods (chips, crackers, etc.); powdered, single serve drink mixes (such as Crystal Light); batteries; stationary items (paper, pens, pencils); playing cards; toys (small stuff, either for the soldiers or for them to hand out to local kids); international phone cards; personal hygiene items (for both men and women). Items need to fit into an 11 7/8" x 3 3/8" x 13 5/8" Flat Rate Box. We can also use cash donations for postage (the cost to mail a package is \$10.95).

If you forget your items on "Collection Sunday", they can also be brought in any Sunday or during the week...just place them in the basket in the white cabinet near the lower level entrance.
