WHY TAKE A MISSION TRIP?

Why take a mission trip? There is plenty of need just down the street. So, why drive 13 hours to St. Louis to serve people there when there are plenty of people in need here in Colorado? A mission trip is a chance not only to serve the people of a new community, it is also a chance to separate yourself - for a bit - from your own life to focus on someone else. This is what we were able to do when we went down to St. Louis. We were able to separate ourselves from our own lives, to help serve a new community.

On our trip, there were many chances to not only serve, but to also share God's love. We served by cleaning up abandoned lots, providing a soccer camp for over 30 immigrant children, helping to move furniture for immigrants moving to St. Louis, and helping repair houses for immigrants. These service projects took place in the mornings and then during the afternoons we did what they called "love projects" during which we were able to share God's love in various ways, such as handing out water in a park, talking with shut-ins, or simply just striking up a conversation with someone at a local mall. In the evenings, we did devotions as a group and went through a training of ways that we could bring what we learned back to our community here in Colorado.

There are many reasons to take a mission trip, but Extreme Faith (the organization through which we took the trip) hoped that one of the reasons we would take this particular trip would be to spur some service projects in our own communities. Our hope and prayer is that during this mission trip, the Holy Spirit worked through and in those who participated to not only share God's love with the people of St. Louis, but to also take some of what they learned home.

Thank you so much for supporting us so that we could go on this trip! We appreciate our community here at Ascension, the support you give, and most importantly, the prayers!
