- 4: Sunday morning Communion will be at the rail, and the requirement of mask for the severs will be dropped as well.
- 5: Visitations by the elders were discussed and a some were scheduled. Due to amazing recovery by Pastor and Parishioners, people returning to worship in person, and some requesting to be communed by the pastor, the Visitation list has been reworked, by Arvin and Pastor John. The Elders are on call if needed.

Board of Trustees Report to Council June 14, 2022

- 1.0 Office Computer Server Replacement Delay: The staff and Pastor Larson will attempt to meet with True Tower Group soon and move to cloud storage and access. We also have a new laptop computer for Pastor to replace his older desktop. The old computer has trouble accessing data online.
- 2.0 Cleaning/ House Keeping Position: Lee Valdez cannot continue to help Ascension with the cleaning tasks. We have obtained two bids from cleaning companies. The bid from Accurate Janitorial Services seems to best meet our needs. Our agreement with them can be cancelled within 30 days. We hope to have them working in the building by Tuesday, June 14. During the summer we are planning to have the building cleaned twice a week.

When the Preschool and Church fall schedule starts we plan to have the building cleaned three times per week.

- 3.0 Security Cameras: The camera system is now operating as planned but the camera monitor in the main office still needs to be brought on-line.
- 4.0 Sprinkler Controls: We now have all our sprinkler systems operating. We replaced one sprinkler control for the Memorial Garden and repaired the connections on the other controller for the east lawn and parking lot.
- Kids Playground: 1. The State Preschool Inspector has asked us to reduce the possible hazard of some of the bolts that secure the fence around the area. The identified bolts are too long and could cause a small child to injure itself. We have several months to fix this situation. 2. Kelly Lafferty, our Preschool Director, was able to purchase some new playground items with a grant. The Boy Scout Troop 361, which meets at Ascension, has agreed to help her assemble the equipment.
- 6.0 Trees in our front yard along Caley Avenue: The limbs from the recent storm that fell to the ground have been removed but we still have some highlanging branches that appear not to be short term a hazard, so we plan to remove them in a timely manner.
