Ascension Lutheran Ladies Guild Report to Council – July 12, 2022

Ladies met for our yearly Planning Day on Saturday June 25<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am – we planned all our dates for July 2022 thru June 2023. We provided all dates to Dawn to put on the Church Calendar and Pastor for reference.

We are still looking for a Vice President

Our first General Meeting will be on Thursday September 22, 2022, at 6:00 pm – Shelly Stewart our new District President will be our Guest Speaker.

Board of Trustees Report to Council July 12, 2022

- 1.0 Kids Playground: 1. Concerning the fence bolts that were too long: Jim Mullane was able to grind down the bolts. 2. Kelly Lafferty, our Preschool Director, was able to purchase some new playground items with a grant. The Boy Scout Troop 361 that meets at Ascension has agreed to help her assemble the equipment.
- 2.0 Trees in our front yard along Caley Avenue: The limbs from the spring storm that fell to the ground have been removed but we still have some highhanging branches that appear not to be short term a hazard, so we plan to remove them in a timely manner. We currently have one bid with the cost between \$400 and \$800 per tree. There are five trees. We will pursue other bids.
- Painting: 1. The Narthex entrance overhang and northeast soffit areas: These have been painted. 2. The ceiling of the Nursery: We have a bid from Bill Rolling to paint the Nursery ceiling for \$450. 3. The Memorial Garden gate: we have a bid to sand and paint the gate for \$250. 4. Columbarium seal: Bill Rolling will look at the seal and repair it at no cost.
- East Parking Lot Entry door: The panic bar on the one of the doors need repair and was replaced with new hardware for under \$700.00 by KenCaryl Glass.
- 5.0 Brown Spots in the grass: When we had a full-time custodian these spots would be hand/sprinkler watered from time-to-time. The issue is usually not the sprinkler heads but the system itself. The system was "volunteer" built and lacks the precision of a true

commercial system. The Trustees have discussed this issue and are discussing the wisdom of removing some of the sprinklers and xeriscaping the "problem" areas. This will reduce our watering costs that grow each year and eliminate the "brown" areas.

Wall Heaters: Two wall heaters, one in the upper West Wing hall and another in the lower hall are having control valve issues. They do not shut off when the thermostat sends them the signal. **These parts were not replaced in the remodel.** Our heating consultants, Pasterkamp Heating and AC, is working on the problem and has a plan to replace these valves before heating season. **We do not know what the cost will be.**
