Board of Trustees Report to Council August 9, 2022

- 1.0 Painting: The ceiling of the Nursery has been painted. The Memorial Garden gate and repairing the seal in the Columbarium are pending.
- 2.0 Northeast Fellowship Entry door: The lock in this door was broken and has been repaired. We have no idea how the lock was broken. There was no other damage to the door.
- 3.0 Toilet in Boys Restroom: The standard toilet had a very small leak. We notified Himmelman Construction and they repaired the leak as part of the warranty on the West Wing.
- 4.0 Lawn Maintenance: Larlees Lawn Service is cutting all the grass. Jim Mullane has agreed to cut the Swale and the field on the west end on an "as needed" bases.
