Board of Trustees
Report to Council

- 1.0 Vent Pipe for the Large Boiler: One of the three cables holding the Vent pipe pulled the "eye Hook" out of the roof. John Rolling had a plate fabricated with four bolt holes with an "eye hook" and installed the plate and secured the cable.
- 2.0 Sprinkler System: Tim's Sprinklers turned on the water and helped mark the sprinkler heads so the lawn could be aerated. We discovered several problems with the system and they returned a couple days later and fixed a large break in the main 2" pipe and replaced heads in the east side lawn so all the area could be watered. We have scheduled another repair time to work on the sprinklers in the south side lawn.
- 3.0 Elevator: We had a failed elevator inspection. There was a small leak in the hydraulic system and the phone was not working. TK Elevator repaired the hydraulic system and CenturyLink repaired the phone connection.
- 4.0 Trustees Shed: Boy Scout Troop 361 has volunteered to paint the shed sometime in late May or early June. We will provide the materials.
- 5.0 Narthex lights: There are four florescent fixtures of the 19 that are not working properly. We are either going to replace those four florescent fixtures or perhaps replace the whole system with LED's. We will keep you posted.
- 6.0 Bell Tower: The Bell Tower Committee is meeting and trying to develop a plan for repairing the structure. Wayne Bue is the Committee Chair.
