Board of Trustees Report to Council July 11, 2023

- 1.0 Water damage: During the recent heavy rain storms we had damage to the wall in Pastor's Office. We have determined that cleaning the gutters has fixed the problem and John Rolling is contacting help to repair the damage.
- 2.0 Sprinklers: Tim's Sprinklers replaced all the non-functioning heads on the south side lawn and we have adequate coverage over all the area. The west fenced area is still a concern, but we need to wait and see what the result of the increased pressure in the repaired supply line accomplishes for the sprinklers in that area before we can decide our next plan of action.
- 3.0 Bell Tower: The Bell Tower Committee has obtained a bid from Eidos Architects to 1. Document the Bell Tower, 2. Research required repairs, 3. Meet with Ascension- two times, and to visit site during construction with Horizon West Builders two times. The bid is divided into Architectural and Electrical. The Bid is \$6,450.00.
