<u>CREATION WINDOW</u>: I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and Earth." The hand of God is reaching out of the dark void, and He said, "Let there be light, and there was light."

The glass circlets surrounding God's hand suggest the very swirling of the atoms, basic building matter of all creation which then bursts into light.

God said, "Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters and let it divide the waters from the dry land." God called the dry land "Earth."

The jagged cliffs remind us of the West, the spot in Creation where God placed us. The three fish suggest the food God gives us as wells as the Trinity whom we confess God to be. The depiction of the first woman and man in a verdant Paradise expresses God's original (and continuing) purpose for us as bearers of His image to share life in fellowship with Him and each other.
