Cross Banners

Shown here is one of a pair of Cross banners; one is olive green and the other is white. The three identical, bubble-shaped background components of each banner are for the unchanging Triune God who reveals Himself as **God the Father**, **God the Son**, and **God the Holy Spirit**. The center crosses are encircled by eight blocks, for the concept that – we live in the perpetual "eighth day" as we wait for Christ's return. The first seven days represent Jesus' ministry, Holy week, crucifixion, death and then resurrection, overcoming death and sin. You will see this symbol on the front of the hymnal. Juxtaposition of the light and dark components is for the sinner/saint and good/evil relationships of the Christian to the world. Green was used to represent the darker color

because much of our growth as Christians comes through and in the trials and tribulations in this life.
