Prayers and Assistance Needed! Rocky Mountain District President Rev. James Maxwell has requested assistance on behalf of Pastor Nathaniel Brown and his wife Laura, of the Minnesota North District. Pastor Brown serves 3 parishes in Minnesota. He and his wife will arrive soon and will be staying here in Denver, far from home, through the holidays, in order that their soon-to-be newborn baby will be able to have needed surgery and post-surgery care right away after birth at Children's Hospital-Aurora. Here are some ways to help Pastor Brown and Mrs. Brown while they are in town:

Update from Pastor Brown: *"The heart has 4 chambers normally. Baby Brown has Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome, so the left ventricle is underdeveloped. He or she will have a "Norwood Procedure" immediately after birth.*

Baby is still doing good, The temporary relocation has been overwhelming for us. But it has been made infinitely easier being part of the Body of Christ.

A Pastor in the Denver area had a child with a similar heart defect as us, so he spearheaded the Denver support to arrange a place to stay, any gift cards that come in.

Laura and I have gone to two different congregations these past two weekends. My wife Laura has said that it is strange walking into a congregation that we have no connections to, and to have people praying for us. And it is very strange. There is no doubt about that. But that isn't really true, that we have no connection to this place. Laura, Baby, and I have had the same Jesus die for our sins as these congregations in Denver, as well as the three congregations I serve, and the elders are doing the services in my stead. Laura and I (and soon Baby too), have been washed in the same Baptismal waters as the strangers who have given us gift cards randomly that we won't

meet until the resurrection of the dead, when Christ our LORD returns in glory. This is the Body of Christ. And it is overwhelming to experience first hand.

A lot of people have asked what they can do, and that is incredibly caring. The first and most important thing you can do is pray. Prayers for Baby to be healthy are incredible. Prayers for us to keep our sanity in the midst of this chaos and through a temporary relocation are needed. Prayers for my three congregations have been my prayers every day. The gift cards, and the Venmo donations are wonderful, especially from strangers that we haven't met. But right now, the money is doing okay, and that might change after Baby is born and has heart surgery. But what I have seen help Laura and I the most is to reach out and talk with us.
