

Update from Pastor Brown on 11/23: *Today, we went to Church, and then went out for brunch, and during our meal, Laura thought that her water broke. We got checked in to the hospital, and they did some tests, and Laura's water did indeed break. So we are in the hospital, waiting for Baby to come. Please keep Mom and Baby in your prayers. This is a bit earlier than expected, since induction date was scheduled for Tuesday night. But now we are on heightened hurry up and wait time.*

Update on 11/24: *What doctors are saying is that Laura's water broke before everything else was ready (there was no fall or anything like that that caused the water to break), so that is why labor has been slow from last update. But Laura is doing great and looks amazing (nurse's comment, I already knew that), and labor is progressing well. Hopeful for this evening/tomorrow before sun comes up for actual delivery.*
